Sonya has been a dedicated volunteer with the Board of States United to Prevent Gun Violence since August 2021, serving as Board Chair from June 2022 to February 2025.

Her involvement in the gun violence prevention movement began in 2012. From 2013 to 2018, she played a key role in establishing the Moms Demand Action chapter in Massachusetts, taking on various leadership positions, including Advocacy and State Deputy Chapter Lead. In September 2018, she joined Stop Handgun Violence (SHV) as a Community Student Organizer, where she amplified the voices of youth inspired by the Parkland school shooting. Since January 2023, she has held the position of Executive Director at SHV.

Before her commitment to gun violence prevention, Sonya worked in corporate accounting, finance, and market research, earning her B.S. in Accounting from Bentley University and M.B.A. at Babson College.
